Please find below some details about the transition package in place for our Year 2 children who are moving up to Forest View in September. We try to make transition between the two schools as seamless as possible. We have had great success with this in the past and will do as much as we can to ensure you find the experience a positive one.



Our shared plans for the rest of the year are as follows:

Tues 13 th May	Mrs Turner-Mitchell (Head of School at Forest View) visited and led an assembly with Y2 pupils at Maun
Tues 10 th June Tues 17 th June Weds 25 th June	Transition Days 1, 2 and 3: Day 1 - Reading/book focus Day 2 - Maths reasoning focus Day 3 - Creative arts and sports focus Maun children should be brought to school as normal. Children will work between the two schools as organised by Y2/Y3 staff.
Thurs 12 th June, 3.45pm	Y2 parent meeting at Forest View
Fri 20 th June	Y6 pupils visit Maun for a Question and Answer Session with Y2 children. Please talk to your children about any questions they might like to ask.
Mon 30 th June - Weds 2 nd July	Y2 Transition Week:
Mon	Y2 pupils are dropped off at Maun as usual by parents/carers, but lunchtime and pick up will be from Forest View (at 3.30pm). Children will spend most of their time in their new classes at Forest View, with Maun staff accompanying initially before gradually retreating during the course of the day.



Tues & Weds	Children will spend the two full days at Forest View (lunchtimes included), and should be dropped off at and picked up from Forest View by parents and carers. Maun staff will be on hand to support with pick-up on both days whilst Year 3 staff get to know you better.
